A Fine White, Still Winning

Although many California wineries have lost interest in the fine Loire grape chenin blanc, Dry Creek Vineyard in Sonoma has championed it for 35 years.

Dry Creek's charming 2006 Chenin is dry but seems almost sweet. Tasted with Kumamoto oysters, it was one of 10 winning whites in the 2007 Pacific Coast Oyster Wine Competition. Chenin's typical traits — peach scent, melon flavor, long aftertaste — come through vividly.
