2006 TAYLOR'S VINEYARD MUSQUÉ
(SAUVIGNON BLANC)
Dry Creek Valley



“Musqué is a specific clone of sauvignon that many winemakers covet for its aromatics. A bit of it in a sauvignon blend adds complexity and contributes mightily to the bouquet. Dry Creek Vineyard takes this one step beyond and bottles a vineyard-designated Musqué from the Dry Creek Valley’s Taylor’s Vineyard. This is a winner from the moment you get a whiff of the attractive floral nose, which shows elements of honeysuckle and white flower. On the palate the Taylor’s Musqué exhibits tropical fruits, fresh melon and spice. Though the palate impression is rounded and fleshy, those luscious flavors are supported by ample mouth-watering acidity.”
